The G20 Agriculture Ministers' Meeting in 2019 highlighted the following three themes as key policy areas in tackling global challenges and achieving a sustainable agro-food sector:

- (1) Fostering innovative human resources and new technologies;
- (2) Focusing on FVCs, facilitating farmers' and other FVCs stakeholders' benefit; and
- (3) Pursuing a possible contribution to achieve SDGs.

The agro-food sector is facing a wide range of issues for which there are neither easy nor "one-size-fits-all" solutions. The Japanese Presidency, believing that exchanging our experiences and ideas would contribute to finding solutions, proposed to collect countries' national experiences, programs, policies and good practices related to the above-mentioned three themes. With support from G20 members and invitees to the Meeting, this information has been compiled in a booklet as an input for Ministers and also as reference material for all related stakeholders.
